

The Strategic Partnership (SP) "Towards a Worldwide Influencing Network" is a Lobby and Advocacy programme with the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The programme enables global and local influencing work on three thematic areas: 1) Right to Food; 2) Greater Responsibility in Finance for Development; 3) Conflict and Fragility. The ambition of the SP is to achieve policy changes by governments and the private sector to the benefit of groups facing poverty and injustice, and to strengthen civil society's capacity to demand for such change. The SP is implemented over a period of 5 years by an Alliance consisting of Oxfam Novib and SOMO.

Project: HaMoked - Conflict & Fragility

HaMoked- Center for the Defence of the Individual will contribute to targeted outcome of the project: international community holds the PA and Israel accountable and advocates for meaningful inclusion, and protection, of women in gender sensitive peace and security processes. HaMoked's contribution will entail providing legal protection for women suffering from Separation Policy that divides them between the West Bank, East Jerusalem and Gaza. HaMoked will challenge the attempt to force relocation of women in divided families through administrative, para-legal and legal intervention. In addition, the HaMoked will prepare advocacy materials through issuing 20 updates and position papers and making relevant legal documents accessible in English and Hebrew. These materials will be used to reinforce global advocacy on behalf of Palestinian women forced to live apart from their spouses and children. Some of the legal efforts will include: 12 legal cases to challenge forced relocation of Palestinian women and provision of legal support on behalf of 20 Palestinian women threatened with separation from their families through new and revised administrative and legal intervention.

Actor: HaMoked: Center for the Defense

HaMoked (Centre for the Defence of the Individual) is an Israeli human rights NGO with the mandate to offer free legal and administrative assistance and advocate on behalf of Palestinian residents of the occupied territories on the West Bank, the Gaza Strip and East Jerusalem, who are victims of human rights violations resulting from Israel's policies. It focuses on the Israeli administrative and judicial system, upholding standards of international human rights law and international humanitarian law. HaMoked was established in 1988, shortly after the outbreak of the first Intifada. The founders were a group of students from the Hebrew University, Palestinians and Israelis. They set up the organisation along the lines of a legal walk-in clinic. Through 2000 HaMoked specialised in a number of subject matters, such as the freedom of movement (exit and entry to and from abroad, travel in the West Bank, entry to Gaza, blockades, closures and checkpoints), detainee rights (tracing of detainees, conditions of detention, administrative detention, torture, family prison visits), violence towards the body and/or property perpetrated by the military, police, general security services and settlers (opening of investigations, civil claims for compensation), house demolition (for security reasons), and family unification and residency rights (West Bank and Jerusalem).
